Fieldwork Study Season Permits

Projects conducting study seasons must submit their request by **September 15** every year with the following information to the AAIA Athens Executive Officer:

- A comprehensive report on the work during the previous field season, accompanied by photographs and plans and catalogues of finds that were studied.
- A detailed description of activities planned for the upcoming season.
- Proposed dates for the upcoming study season.
- A list of project members along with their affiliation and specialties.

The AAIA is required to submit all applications for study seasons to the relevant Ephorates and the Ministry of Culture by November 30 every year. Permits for a study season are issued directly by the local Ephorates of Antiquities.

Fieldwork projects can apply for both a study season permit and a fieldwork permit for the same year of activity. Please note that up to a total period of 8 weeks of activity is allowed.
