Fieldwork Study Season Permits

Study seasons can be conducted at any time during the year and be of a duration as specified by each project. Study seasons may be conducted at any time during the year and for a duration appropriate to the needs of the project. Where a project intends to undertake both fieldwork and a study season within the same calendar year, permission for both may be requested in a single application.

Projects intending to conduct a study season in the following calendar year must submit their application to the AAIA Athens Executive Officer by **15 September**, including the following information:

- A comprehensive report on work undertaken during the previous field and/or study season, as applicable.
- After consultation with the relevant Ephorate of Antiquities, each project should provide any additional documentation as requested by the Ephorate (such as photographs, plans, and catalogues of finds that were studied during the previous field or study season).
- A detailed description of activities planned for the upcoming season.
- Proposed dates for the upcoming study season.
- A list of project members, including their institutional affiliations and areas of expertise.

Study season permits are issued by the relevant Ephorates of Antiquities. All applications must, however, be submitted through the AAIA. Projects must submit their applications to the AAIA by 15 September for study seasons planned for the following calendar year. Following review and any necessary consultation with the relevant Ephorate, the AAIA submits applications to the appropriate Ephorates by **30 November**.

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
